International BUSINESS FORUM in ChNU...

On February 24 in Chernivtsi University the International Business Forum "Mutual cooperation - the path to the development of Polish and Ukrainian enterprises" brought together the representatives of consulting firms, accounting firms, real estate sector, industry, local government officials, academia and organizations from Poland and Ukraine and NGO Association of Alumni-Entrepreneurs BUKEANA, which is established under the TEMPUS project EUNET.

The aim of this Business Forum consists in presentation of Polish and Ukrainian potential for further cooperation and common development by encouraging integration processes in Ukraine, as well as in the outline of the main directions of partnership between Rzeszow and Chernivtsi.

The organizers of the business forum are a Polish Center of Law 'IUSTUS' and NGO "Center for Economic Initiatives" with the participation of the Faculty of Economics of Chernivtsi University and BUKEANA Association.



The honorary patronage of the event was provided by the Mayor of Rzeszów Tadeusz Ferenc, the mayor of Chernivtsi Alex Kaspruk and rector of Chernivtsi University Stepan Melnychuk.

The Vice-Rector of Chernivtsi University Roman Ivanovich Petrishin greeted the participants of the forum. "We give students theoretical knowledge, and such activities as this forum, I hope, will enable our students and teachers to get practical skills" - he said in his speech.

The forum with the participation of NGO BUKEANA discussed the competitive advantages of Chernivtsi region; obtaining the right of residence, and later - Polish citizenship; principles of working in the Polish firms; examples of successful starting of the company and doing business in Poland; the possibility of obtaining grants for the development of their own business from EU funds.

These and other key issues forum were outlined in the presentations and reports of special guests, including the leader of Service Management of Investors of Rzeszów Waldemar Maheta, vice president of Subcarpathian department of the Association of Accountants (Poland) Dr. Alfred Shydelko, head of the law firm 'GM Consulting' Mariusz Tyvonyuk and others.

Students and professors of Faculty of Economics of Chernivtsi University, which for many years is a research center of Bukovina in the field of economy, and which recently celebrated its 45th anniversary took an active part in the business forum.

The Dean of the Faculty of Economics Ruslan Biloskurskyi said in his speech at the forum: "For our faculty international vector of development is a priority. In this context, our interest lies in the cooperation with Polish universities, because today there is an exchange of students – tomorrow there is business collaboration."

Business Forum organizers are confident that this meeting will provide an opportunity to not only combine the knowledge and experience to look at economic development through international prize, and will be an important element of cooperation between Rzeszow and Chernivtsi in the academic environment in particular.

Results of survey for Business League of KROK University



On the request of the Association of "KROK" University the students of Marketing major of College of Economics, Law and IT, that is a structural subdivision of "KROK" University, conducted a survey "Portrait of KEPIT alumnus 2006-2014".

More than 150 alumni were interviewed. The information on professional and academic life of college graduates, the areas of activities they are engaged in, what achievements they are proud of, how and what they can share with the University was included into the survey. According to the results, 76% of alumni are working, 20% continue their education. College alumni are proud of their achievements: in the professional sphere – 55%, in creation of family and children – 25%, that indicates the interests of young people in the age up to 30. More than 50% are employed, 10% are entrepreneurs, 8% - freelancers, 2% preferred public service and social activities.




75% of respondents are interested in the possibility of further communication and collaboration through the Alumni Club of KEPIT. An interesting fact is that 78% of college alumni were found via social networks. About 15 KEPIT alumni are entrepreneurs and they are willing to join Business League of "KROK" University Alumni Association.

The meeting was attended by representatives of the project team of entrepreneurs BUKEANA Chernivtsi University (Dr. Yu. O. Ushenko, Assoc.Prof. O.V. Dubolazov) and chairman of the student trade union committee V.Yu. Kindzersky together with the student trade union representatives of 11 faculties.

They discussed the charter of the Association of alumni-entrepreneurs BUKEANA. It was stated that the CNU Alumni Association serves as a platform that brings together graduates of different years and thus confirms the legitimacy of Chernivtsi University. The mission of the Association is to bring together the graduates of different years in one community, by consistent efforts to promote the development of both internal and external business communications, development of the university, its decision to solve more strategic problems.

The schedule for questioning was agreed. The procedure of admission of Master's graduates to Association of alumni-entrepreneurs BUKEANA was approved. Drawing up a list of benefits to members of Association of alumni-entrepreneurs BUKEANA was also discussed.

An interview for the "New Formaty" newspaper...

On February 27, 2016, the head of the Association BUKEANA prof. O.G. Ushenko met a correspondent of the newspaper "New Formaty" in the premises of the Department of Optics, Publishing and Printing of the Institute of Physics, Technology and Computer Sciences as part of the activities plan of the Association of alumni-entrepreneurs BUKEANA of Chernivtsi National University (ChNU).



The topic of the meeting was related to the history of the formation of the TEMPUS grant project EANET, objectives and prospects of the Association of Alumni-Entrepreneurs BUKEANA of Chernivtsi University, and further scheduled events.

Prof. O.G. Ushenko described the general provisions of the NGO "Association of alumni of Chernivtsi University." He noted that the Alumni Association is based on the equal rights of its members, government and law under the Constitution of Ukraine, the Public Code of Ukraine, the Law of Ukraine "On public associations" and is guided by the statute of the NGO "Association of alumni". The Association promotes the rights and legitimate interests of Chernivtsi National University graduates-members and helps in strengthening the ChNU position in the educational market. The Association should be transparent, and the information concerning its founding and program documents – public. The Association coordinates its work with the Rector of Chernivtsi University. Besides, the aim of the Alumni Association was outlined: the effective use of the potential for a comprehensive solution of problems and tasks of the University; it is especially important on the increasingly competitive market for educational services. In the course of its activity the Association is to promote a positive image of ChNU both within Ukraine and abroad, to unite graduates of different years and their more successful advancement in society and to facilitate the solution of various social problems among graduates and students of the educational institution, mainly, concerning their employment and business communications.

Prof. O.G. Ushenko presented information about the Association website, the terms of admission to it, the list of benefits and major upcoming events - master classes, workshops and regional seminars with representatives of business, science and government of Bukovina.
